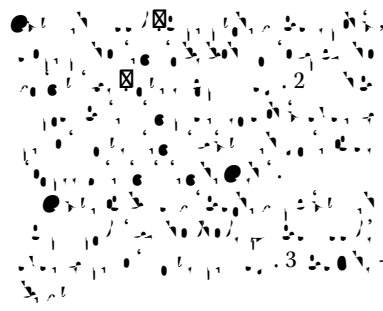

Salary interest arbitration decision reached

After a year of negotiations, the University of Victoria and the University Employees' Association have reached a salary interest arbitration decision. The decision, which was reached on January 15, 2014, provides for a 3.5% increase in base salaries for the 2014-15 fiscal year. The decision also includes provisions for a new performance-based bonus system, a new pension plan, and a new health and dental plan. The decision is a significant step forward in the negotiations and is expected to be implemented in the coming months.

New site for UVic Plant Sale

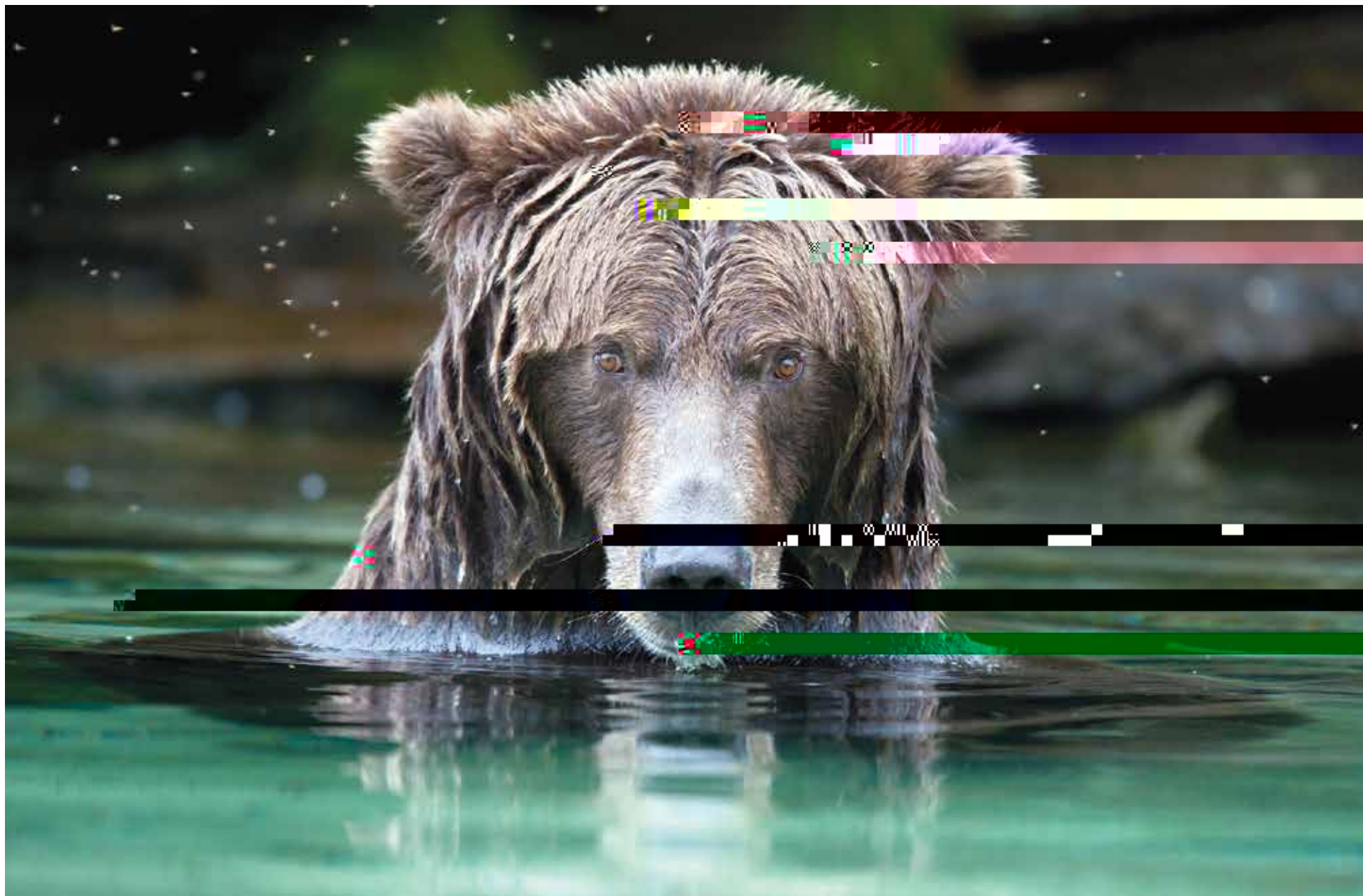

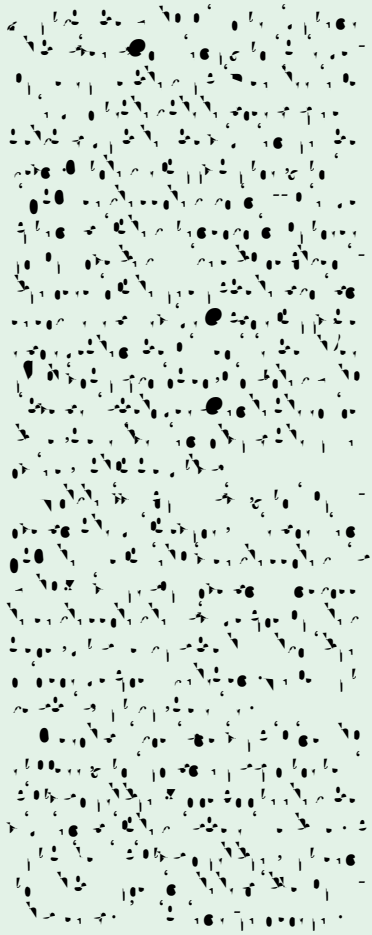
