Site prep begins for student housing and dining project

Although construction for the university's student housing and dining project won't kick o until 2020, early preparation work at the site will begin this spring and summer. Starting in May, watch for selective deconstruction, road and utility work around the Cadboro Commons and SUB buildings. Exterior concrete pedestrian walkways, stairs and walls at Cadboro Commons will be deconstructed, and the access lane from Sinclair Road to the rear of the SUB will be widened—with the addition of an improved, marked crossing for the Alumni Chip Trail. 
