We have also seen TAs who have performed poorly initially, but improved progressively and became great TA's. Effective fall 2013, to ensure a minimum consistent standard among TA's, the department established the following policy on mandatory TA workshops:

- 1. All new graduate students or those who haven't been appointed as TA before in the faculty are required to attend the workshop:

- 2. All new graduate students or those who haven't been appointed as TA before in the faculty, and for whom English is a second language, are required to attend the workshop:
