## Process for Requesting Readmission Upon withdrawal from the PhD Program

PhD students who have previously withdrawn from the University of Victoria, School of Nursing PhD program may be permitted, with the approval of the Associate Director, Graduate Education, the PhD Program Coordinator and the student's supervisor to request readmission to the PhD Program. The student must submit a request to the PhD Program Coordinator, and the student's

desire to be considered for readmission to the program.

If the readmission request is received within one year of the student's withdrawal from the PhD program, the readmission request will be reviewed by the PhD selections committee on an individual basis. The student will be required to provide the PhD Program Coordinator with the following documentation for consideration:

1. Letter of Intent<sup>1</sup>
2. Rationale for Readmission to the University of Victoria School of Nursing PhD Program
3. Plan for Program completion to be designed with and signed by, the student's PhD supervisor.

If the period of withdrawal exceeds 12 months, the student's readmission request (consisting of the documents listed above) will be considered during the regular cycle of admitting students to the PhD program.
