## **PRE-REQUISITE COURSES**

There are two specific pre-requisites for Social Work courses: SOCW 200A: An Introduction to Social Work Practice and SOCW 200B: Introduction to the Critical Analysis of Social Welfare in Canada. These courses must be in progress or completed at the time of your application.

Here are a few options for taking SOCW 200A and SOCW 200B:

- 1. UVIC offers both SOCW 200A and SOCW 200B every semester by distance education and often on campus as well. If you are not a UVic student, you must <u>complete a separate application</u> for Social Science: Pre-Social Work in order to take these courses.
