All new applicants are evaluated for the University Fellowship and new student graduate awards. Successful incoming students are notified of their awards with their admission offer. The minimum standard required for consideration for these awards is total standard (Aaverage). Grade calculations and equivalencies are determined by the Graduate Admissions and Records Office.
