The Indigenous Studies Program invites expressions of interest for sessional lecturers to teach the following courses in the Fall 2023 (Sept-Dec) and Winter (Jan-Apr) academic term:

IS 201 Introduction to Indigenous Studies (1.5 Units) 3 hours per week Fall 2023

Introduces students to historical, social, political, legal, and gendered frameworks that shape the relationship between Indigenous peoples, the state of Canada and Canadian society. Topics include political activism, constitutional reform and recognition, policy, treaties and land claims.

The University reserves the right to fill additional teaching assignments from the pool of applicants for this posting. The position may be re-posted if not filled and is subject to satisfactory course enrollment.
