Important to Note: Students are encouraged to consult the instructor with any problems or concerns about the course **early** in the semester.

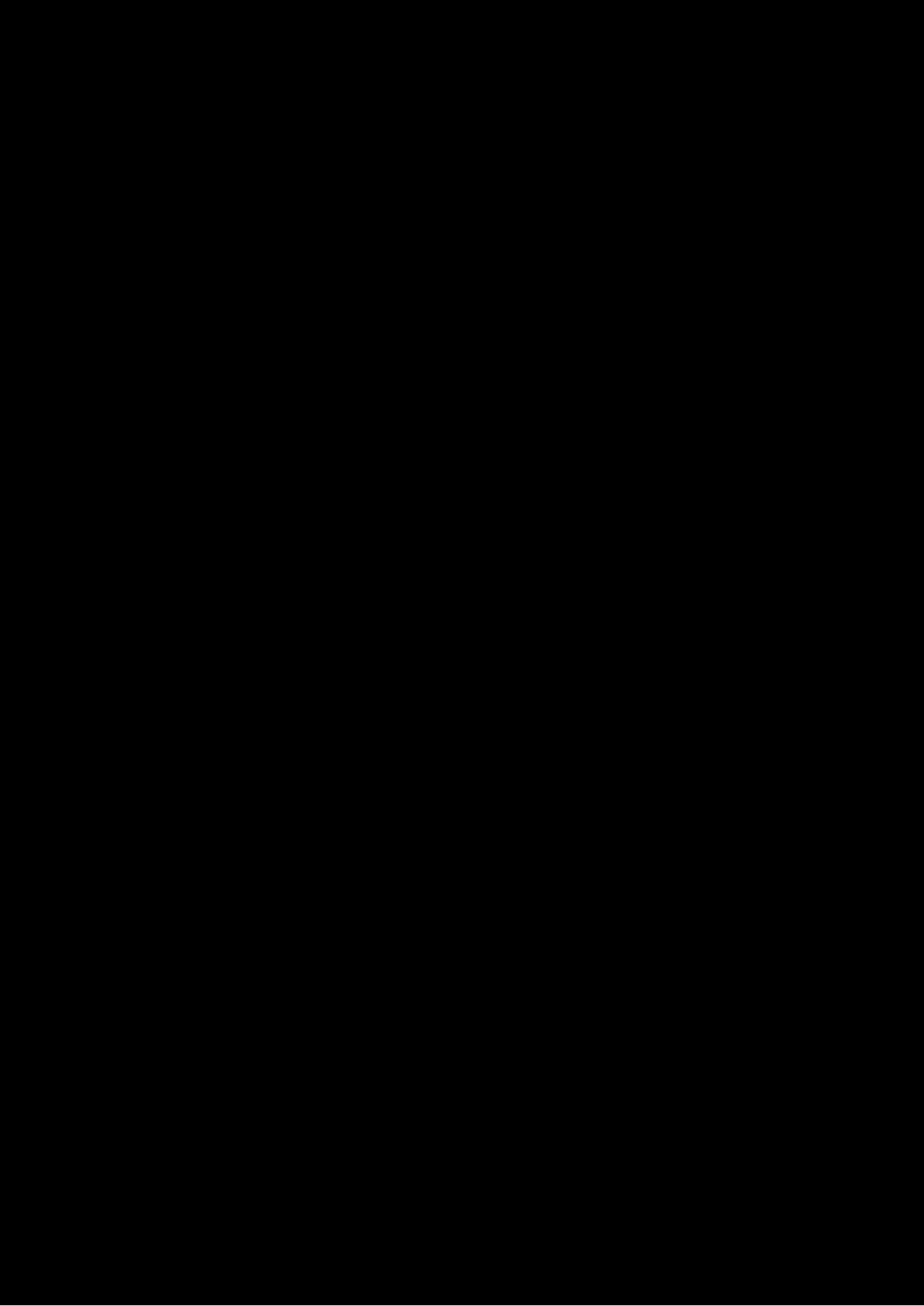
Grading System:
