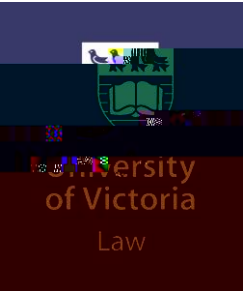


Supervisory Committee Structure
