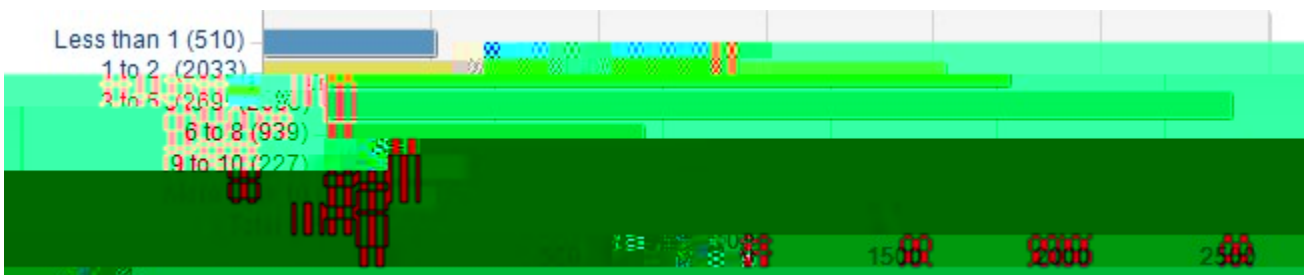

experience?



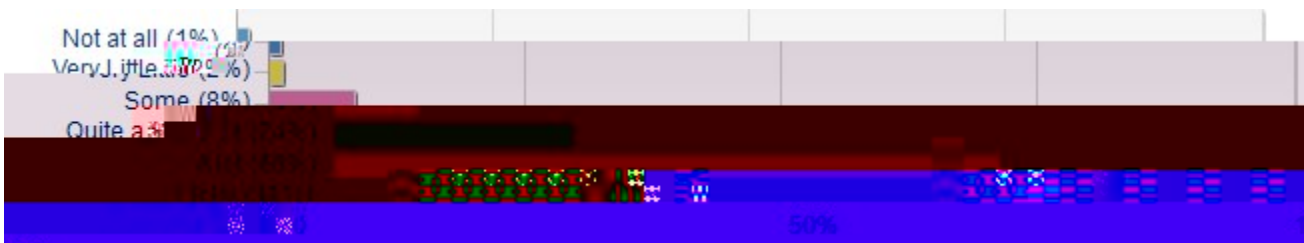
