3.3 University Safety Committee (USC) Update Nykita provided the following update:

New Business

a. Consultation topic: Ergonomics

Cathy provided an overview of the university's ergonomics program that she leads in HR. The services focus on prevention and education as well as providing resources.

Encampment update

Rob advised that the provincial government has created a document to help inform post-secondary institutions on the management of encampments and actions to consider.
