## 3. Non-Personal Product Issue

Where it has been identified that the source of discomfort may be associated with a nonpersonal product (e.g., scented cleaning solution, deodourizers, air fresheners), the university may have to adjust the use of these products. Any suggested changes to custodial services should be discussed with Facilities Management. Other non-personal product issues (e.g. office supplies, markers, plants, etc.) should be discussed within the unit and resolved seeking cooperation between employees and management.

## Additional Considerations for Employees with a Medical Condition or Disability
