JOB DESCRIPTION:

With the guidance of SOCC's Coordinator as well as Collective members, the Education Coordinator will be responsible for the following:

1. Assist in the planning of workshops or events on topics related to anti-racism, systemic oppression, BIPOC peoples struggles and histories, collective liberation, and more!
2. Assist in the development of educational resources-these could be in the form of social media posts, pamphlets, leaflets, zines, or resource packs;
3. Occasionally facilitate discussions, meetings, or workshops;
4. Attend anti-racism meetings or events on behalf of SOCC;
5. Report progress to the Collective during monthly meetings;

4. Experience creating safe and accessible spaces for discussion and learning
