

Financial CO Compliance for US Public Health Service Agencies

Information for applicants and grant holders on the US Public Health Service Agencies:

A number of US Public Health Service (PHS) agencies, including NH, have implemented stringent new training and reporting requirements for significant Financial Conflicts of Interest (FCOI) that affect all investigators and co-investigators, their spouses and their dependent children.

To remain eligible for funding, all current grant-holders and new applicants must immediately follow the steps below:

1. Complete and Submit the [UVC Significant Financial Interest \(SFI\) Disclosure and Consent Form](#) listing his or her known financial interests and those of his/her spouse/partner and/or dependent children.

Please note that the Disclosure Form is set up so that the SFI of the investigator, spouse/partner, and/or dependent children are all disclosed on a single form.

Please submit the completed forms to Dr. [Name] at [Address] for this process at the time of application for funding.

Please note that you are required to file an updated Disclosure form annually and within 30 days of discovering or acquiring a new SFI.

If any conflicts

are identified, the DO will contact you to determine the course of action according to the regulations.

2. Complete prior to the research, and every four years thereafter.
