3. Make giant raffle tickets.

- a. Distribute the Raffle Ticket handout (G P V O E B U U I F F O E P G U I (if refer to David N I F O U one from your school) and give students an opportunity to read, understand and assess it. Then facilitate a class discussion. You may want to ask:
 - i. Do you think this raffle ticket is worth the money? Why or why not?
 - ii. How do you decide what something is worth? What are your criteria? Give examples.
- b. Divide the class into pairs and give each group poster paper and art supplies, and a "worthy cause" such as climate change. Or invite them to choose their own cause that reflects their understanding of their community or world and their identity within itgg
