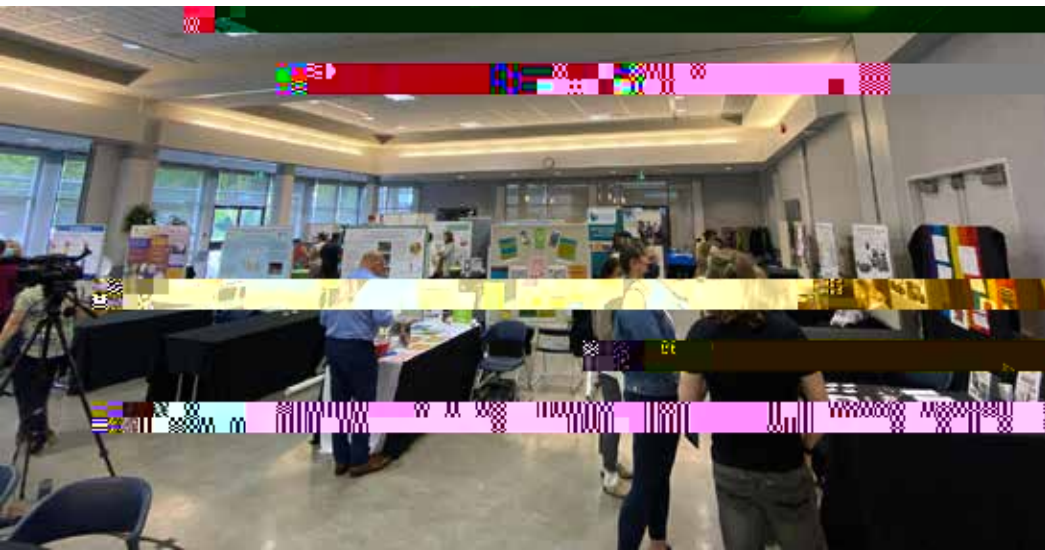

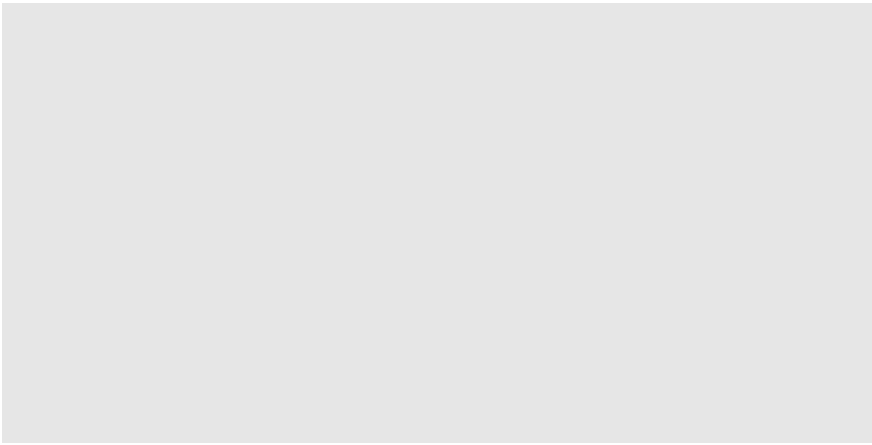

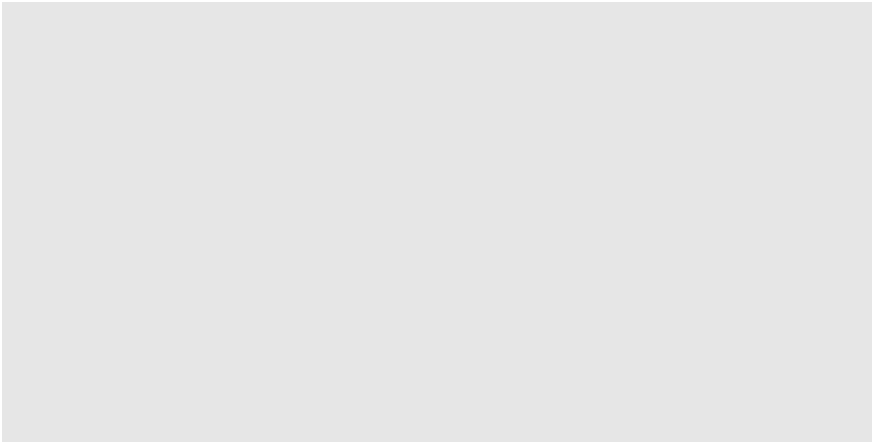

For the first panel of the event, the panelist and the moderator discussed various programs for children and youth. During the discussion, they exchanged perspectives about the benefits and consequences of long-established and recent programs in relation to mental health of children and youth.



The second panel focused more on innovating the current program for children and youth. They focused on the strengths and contributions of youth to their families, schools, and communities, and on youth who are vulnerable due to societal, family, and community challenges.

The discussion panel were presented as an opportunity for disseminating knowledge about the various challenges surrounding funding, collaboration, and experience regarding children and youth programs. The panelist also shared the success of some initiatives and the availability of resources for youth, which provided information and guidance for attendees and related organizations to overcome funding and collaboration difficulties.

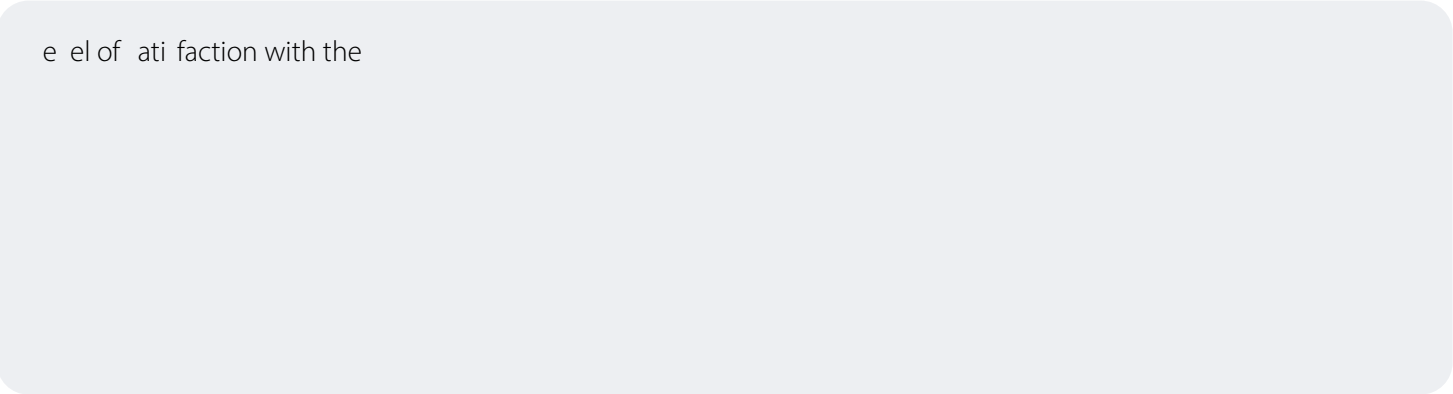
