The Oneida Field School (Indigenous Knowledge, Mapping, and Environmental Stewardship) is based on the Oneida Territory, where students will camp around the nation's Longhouse. The class runs from July 8th - 15th, 2024. The class is offered in partnership with Oneida Nation in order to both map and outline strategies increasing food security and food sovereignty for the nation, as well as addressing the colonial impacts to the environment for Oneida.
