What Is The Psychology Honours Program

The Psychology Honours Program is a senior undergraduate capstone experience that provides students with the opportunity to:

- (1) Complete an original research project under the supervision of a faculty member, spanning from the development of a research question to the write-up of a thesis in the field's accepted APA format; all over the course of an academic year, September to April.
- (2) Simultaneous participation in the Psychology 499 Honours Seminar, which supports the completion of each step of the Honours research project in a small group of highly, qualified students led by a faculty member. The Honours advisor

- Psyc 499 (Honours Project & Seminar, September to April)
- Psyc 400A (Advanced Statistical Methods) for Psychology Majors*
