## What Is The Psychology Honours Program

The Psychology Honours Program is a senior undergraduate capstone experience that provides students with the opportunity to:

- Complete an original research project under the supervision of a faculty member, spanning from the development of a research question to the write-up of a thesis in the field's accepted APA format; all over the course of an academic year, September to April.
