Guidelines for Selecting Nominees for Graduate Donor Awards

<u>Deadline: noon August 31, 2018</u>

4. For the UVic-wide awards, the following criteria and associated weights will be used.

Criterion	Weight (%) ^a
Research productivity (publications, presentations)	40
Cumulative grad GPA (last 2 yrs of undergrad GPA for 1st yr students)	40
Professional activities & leadership skills	10
Awards, fellowships, & scholarships	10

^aNote: the weights here are different than in #3 because competition for these awards is across all of UVic where GPA will play a bigger role.

- 5. **For the Petch and Strong President's Research Scholarships**: The top ranked student who holds a UVic fellowship or major Canadian national award valued between \$15,000 and \$25,000 will be nominated for the Strong and Petch Scholarships (8 in total for UVic). [Note: departments can nominate only **one** student for this pool of awards.]
- 6. Students can hold a particular donor award only once per degree.
- 7. Within any one round of competitions, the same student could typically be nominated for a maximum of two donor
