Electronic voting

- 11.6 In order tovote electronically voters will be required to verify their eligibility by means specified by the University Secretary
- 11.7 Voters may vote forup to the number of candidates that corresponds the number of vacant seats or may opt to spthie ir ballots.

<u>Paperballots</u>

11.8 A person entitled to vote will mark his/heaperballot, then insert it into a ballot envelope and insert the ballot envelope into an identification envelope. The person voting must identify him/herself by completing the identifon

- 11.14 Paper ballots and bentification envelopes will be held by the University Secretary for a period of one year (in accordance with tion 31 of the) following the announcement of election results. At the end of that time the paper ballots and identification envelopes will be on fidentially destroyed
- 11.15 The official results of each election, as validated by the University Secretary and the scrutineers, wilbe retained by the University Secretary until such time as they are transferred to the inversity archives in accordance with the university's recordsmanagement manual.

- 14.1 Any complaints about the election predures campaigning results must be made in writing to the Senate Committeen Agenda anc Governance in care of the University Secretary within five (5) business days of the announcement of the election results
