g) Sustainability

The Committee shall consider matters related to the advancement of sustainability in the physical development of the campus, including in new building construction, major renovation projects, infrastructure projects and in campus planning decisions and implementation. The Campus Sustainability Guidelines and the Campus Design Guidelines, the Sustainability Policy and the Sustainability Action Plan for Campus Operations provide information that can assist in the implementation of the sustainability policies in the Campus Plan.

3. Sub-Committees

The Committee may appoint sub-committees and workgroups that may assist the Committee in carrying out its mandate, and dissolve them as necessary; to establish terms of reference and memberships, to ensure that these subcommittees and workgroups report to the President on a regular basis, and to consider their reports and recommendations on such matters as planning studies and area plans related to Campus Plan implementation, environmental plans, and Campus Plan monitoring.
